BASEline is a powerful self-reporting tool to identify students' mental health competencies across four categories and measure growth, allowing teachers to personalize instruction.

With the **BASEline Assessment Screener**, schools can assess their students' growth at predetermined intervals throughout the year to ensure that students are achieving desired outcomes.

It is recommended that students take the BASEline assessment three times per year, which provides data points to gauge growth across the following four catergories.





How BASEline works?

Pre-Assessment: Each student answers simple questions about their behavior, engagement, academic confidence, and social connectivity.

Course Recommendations: Once students take the BASEline assessment, they will be assigned a personalized pathway of course modules designed specifically for improving the identified areas of need.

Post-Assessment: Upon completing the assigned modules, BASEline is re-administered to show pre- and post-test results. Administrators are dynamically informed with charts and graphs as to the effectiveness of the instruction.
