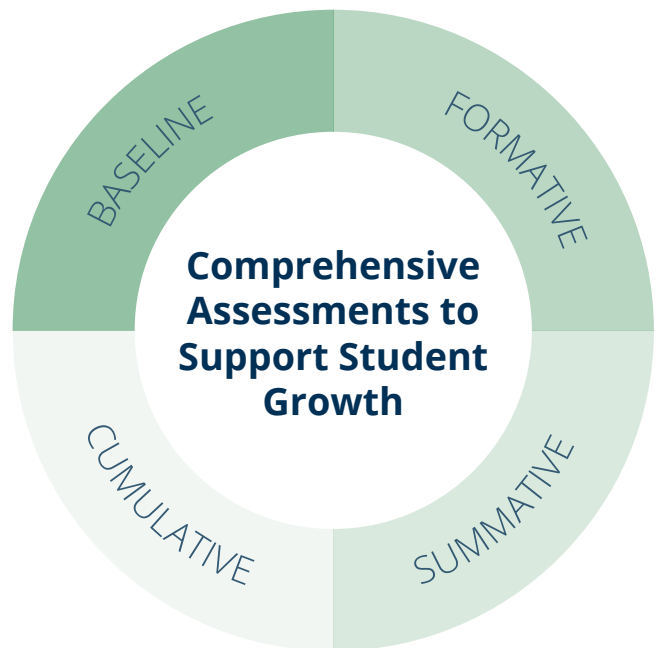

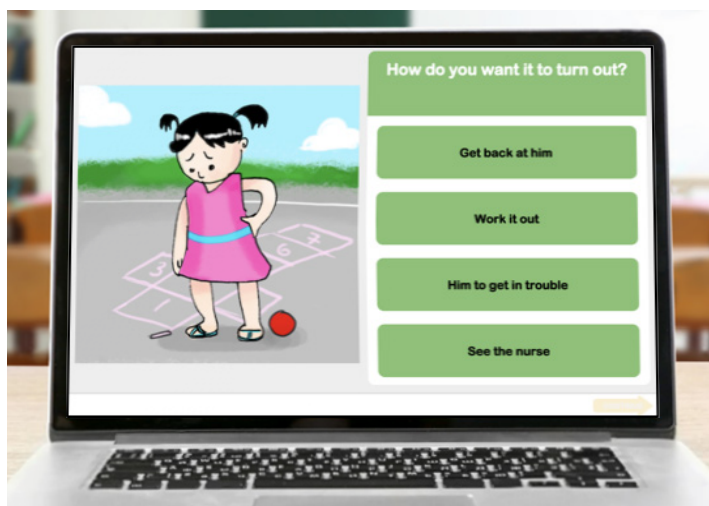

K-12 School Climate Survey

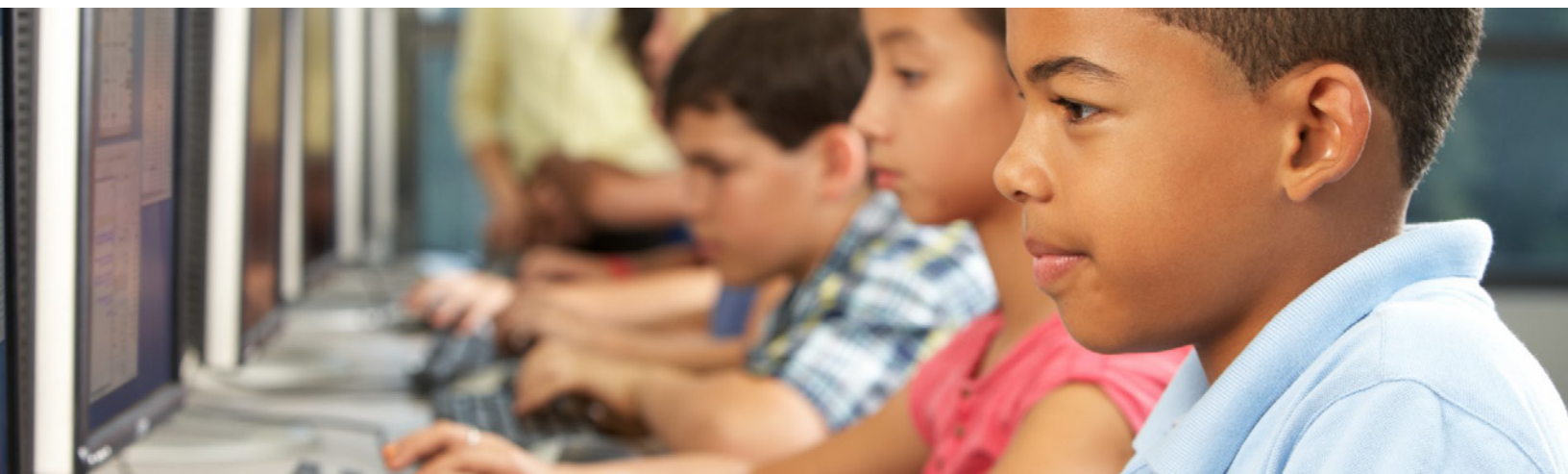
All Insights assessments include a climate survey measuring essential learning conditions, including students' sense of safety, belonging, and instructional support.
